Ziplining 4-line or 7-line Adventure

Soar over the valleys of the West Maui mountains while enjoying panoramic views of three Hawaiian islands, as well as tropical forests, native pineapple fields, and lush waterfalls. The 4-line features some of the fastest and longest lines on the mountain.

The 7-line adventure will awaken your adrenaline and curiosity as you fly over the West Maui Mountains via seven ziplines covering two miles of parallel cable lines! From the mountain outpost, you'll continue your ascent to the upper reaches in a four wheel drive Polaris Ranger to "climb" the upper reaches of the adventure course.

Experience the natural splendor of Maui from the exotic native forests as you glide through the air.

Hana & Haleakalā Helicopter Tour from Kahului

A wonderful exploration of the most popular points of interest on the island. These include Haleakalā National Park, Haleakalā Crater, Manawainui, Oheo Gulch (Seven Pools), Hana town and the Hana Rainforest Preserve, which is the largest rainforest in the United States. See dozens of beautiful waterfalls, Keanae valley, and the rugged shoreline of East Maui.

West Maui & Molokai Helicopter Tour from Kahului

Explore deep, meandering valleys set in the rainforest of the ancient West Maui Mountains. Knife-edged ridges with mist-shrouded peaks separate the spectacular valleys. Waterfalls cascade down from towering cliffs into the streams running along the rainforest floor. See the famous lao valley and learn about the history and culture of the sights from your pilot. Cross the Pailolo channel to the "Friendly Isle." Molokai has the world's highest sea cliffs, Hawaii's tallest waterfall, remote valleys and the famous Kalaupapa peninsula.



Haleakelā Sunrise or Day Bike Tour

This package includes round trip transportation from The Ritz-Carlton as well as hot & cold beverages and muffins at "base camp," park entrance fees, bikes & gear (DOT approved helmets, gloves, wind-stopper fleece, Gortex™ rain suits), and safety instruction. To begin your tour you will be treated to a fully narrated land tour of Haleakalā National Park. Once inside the park, you may exit the vehicle and stand at the rim of the crater, enjoy the visitor center and see the rare Silversword plant. Your bicycle tour begins at the 6500 ft. elevation where you will gently descend the 21 switchbacks on the western slopes of the world's largest resting volcano. Enjoy full bi-coastal panoramas of Maui's central valley, the West Maui mountains, and the neighbor islands with photo stops to capture Maui's beautiful landscape and the open range of Haleakalā Ranch. Glide through upcountry eucalyptus forests, past Jacaranda trees, the colorful lavender farms in Kula and more.

Activity Level: Moderate-Some physical activity required Recommended Attire: Closed toe shoes, dress in layers, sunscreen and sunglasses Tour Requirements: This tour is not for beginners or pregnant women. Must be at least 4'11" tall and 12 years old. There is a 280 lb weight restriction. Bring a light jacket. Please bring cash for the second meal stop. Trip is weather permitting.

Parasailing is like floating on air as a Parasail vessels pulls you along the coastline. The crew will let out 800 or 1200 feet of line to give you breathtaking views of Maui and the neighboring islands. Tandem and Single harness rides are offered. Each ride lasts approximately 8 to 10 minutes. Our custom designed hydraulic launch and recovery system both launches and returns you directly to the flight deck, assuring passengers of both comfort and safety.



All ages are encouraged to experience Hawaii's oldest sport. Whether you are a beginner, intermediate, or advanced surfer, lessons are offered for all levels.



ATV Tour

West Maui's only ultimate off-road adventure. Enjoy a ride in your own Polaris Ranger through cattle pastures on private dirt roads and trails. You'll stop at "The Garden," where a short hike will take you to the cliff lookout, a spectacular scenic view of the beautiful tropical landscapes of Kahoma Valley and the West Maui Mountains. Relax with water and soda, snacks and tropical fruits at "The Garden." Gear up, get ready, get dirty and experience the time of your life! Total off road ATV drive time for this tour is approximately 1 hour 25 minutes.

On the afternoon tour you can also combine the ATV tour with a waterslide! Following an off-road adventurous ride up the mountain, what better way to rinse and off than a refreshing dip in the Kahoma Ranch freshwater reservoir, after going down a thrilling mountain water slide. Total off road ATV drive time for this tour is approximately 45 minutes. Total time at waterslide is approximately 40 minutes.

Recommended Attire: Long pants and closed toe shoes. For waterslide, bring a bathing suit and towel. Be prepared to get dirty.




